Van Drivers will pick up girls from school and drop them off at the Center. Help our girls arrive safely to the Center for their after-school program activities.

Compensation: \$21.00 per hour

Time: Monday – Friday from 2pm to 4:45pm, Approximately 10 – 12 hours per week

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Pick up girls at designated schools and drive them to Girls Inc. of Metro Denver.
- Enforce safety and discipline standards pursuant to Girls Inc. policy.
- Report any maintenance needs to staff.
- Preserve safe driving standards in a 15-passenger van or shuttle.
- Fill up vans 1-2 times a week.
- Commit to 3 hour van training prior to driving along with a driving test and driving evaluations as needed.
- Support youth ages 5 – 14 by providing a safe and welcoming transportation experience working with girls of all background and cultures.

Requirements:

- Possess a valid Colorado driver's license, with a minimum of two years driving experience.
- Must be 21 years or older.
- Two or more moving violations will not be eligible to operate the fleet.
- Alcohol or drug related offence in the last five years will not be eligible.
- Must be able to commit to 3 hour van training prior to driving along with a driving test.
- Minimum of two years of driving experience.
- Experience driving a 15-passenger vehicle preferred but not required.

Experience:

- Minimum of two years driving experience.
- Experience supporting youth, ages 5-14.
